

Various Roads, Exeter, Proposed Traffic Orders

Devon County Council propose to make these under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Exeter) (Residents Parking) Amendment Order to introduce

No Waiting At Any Time in sections of West Garth Road, Wrefords Drive & Wrefords Lane;

No Waiting 10am–4pm in section of Wrefords Lane;

Limited Waiting Mon-Fri 10am-4pm 2 Hours No Return Within 4 Hours (Exemption for Residents Zone S5 Permit Holders) on specified lengths on Wrefords Lane;

Residents Parking (Zonal) Mon-Fri 8am-6pm Zone S4 on specified lengths of Elmdon Close & Pennsylvania Close;

Residents Parking Mon-Fri 10am-4pm Zone S5 on specified lengths of Wrefords Lane;

Residents Parking (Zonal) Mon-Fri 8am-6pm Zone H on specified lengths of Addington Court, Horseguards & The Quadrangle (all sections).

Residents, charity business occupier £30 annually, visitor permits £30 per batch of 30, business permits annual cost: 1st permit £30, 2nd permit £75, 3rd permit £150; guest house/hotel visitors permit £30 per batch of 20 permits;

Where appropriate there will be the usual exemptions including those in relation to the picking up & setting down of passengers, loading/unloading of goods & disabled persons vehicles.

Devon County Council (Elmdon Close & Pennsylvania Close, Exeter) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Revocation) Order to revoke motor vehicle prohibitions on Elmdon Close & Pennsylvania Close

statement of reasons

The proposals aim to introduce extensions to residents parking schemes that have been agreed for advertising, to improve access and to improve parking options for local residents. This includes the revocation of existing motor vehicle prohibitions.

The restrictions are proposed to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians) and to preserve/improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
